The Fourth Croatian Symposium on early childhood intervention is focused on the three fundamental issues of the Croatian support system: its comprehensiveness, equity and quality. These issues are particularly important in terms of the long-lasting economic crisis and increasing poverty affecting all strata of society, especially the most vulnerable one – children with developmental risks or disabilities and their families. Focusing on these issues, we want to show our opposition to the existing fragmentation of early intervention, the growing commercialization and lack of concern for its quality and availability, because as such, all this does not ensure the fundamental rights of every child.

The symposium will be held in Međimurje County in Sveti Martin na Muri from 1st to 3rd October 2015, in cooperation with the Međimurje Association on Early Childhood Intervention and, as always, with the UNICEF Office for Croatia. Through plenary lectures, symposia presentations, workshops and discussions we will try to find answers for ensuring the comprehensiveness of the system, providing equal access to resources for each child and family, and improving the quality of the system by strengthening our evaluation procedures.
